



National Fuel Announces 108 Years of Uninterrupted Dividend Payments and 40 Consecutive Years of Increases

(June 10, 2010) Williamsville, New York: The Board of Directors of National Fuel Gas Company (NYSE: NFG) ("National Fuel" or "Company") today approved a 3 percent increase in the dividend on the Company's common stock, raising the quarterly rate from 33.5 cents per share as approved in June 2009 to 34.5 cents per share, for an annual rate of \$1.38 per share. This action marks the 108th year of uninterrupted dividend payments and the 40th consecutive year that National Fuel has increased its dividend.

David F. Smith, Chairman of the Board, President and Chief Executive Officer of National Fuel, said, "We are pleased to announce another increase in our dividend. We take significant pride in our dividend history and are pleased that our balanced and integrated business model continues to generate value for our shareholders. The value of our dividend is enhanced by the favorable federal tax treatment that dividends currently receive."

The dividend is payable July 15, 2010, to shareholders of record at the close of business on June 30, 2010. The Company has approximately 81.9 million shares of common stock outstanding. It has no preferred stock outstanding.

National Fuel supports the efforts of the national grassroots advocacy campaign "Defend My Dividend," which is seeking to extend the preferred federal tax rate on dividends.
